Pivot

Stick figure animation. You will have 2 class periods to complete a short animation.

- 1. Click on the yellow taskbar folder.
- 2. Click on This PC on the left side options.
- 3. Double click on Timberwolves Common.
- 4. Double click on ZANANDREA Common yellow folder.
- 5. Pull the entire Pivot folder onto your desktop. It'll make a copy of the folder on your desktop.
- 6. Close ZANANDREA Common folder.
- 7. Double click on your copy of the Pivot Folder.
- 8. Double click on the Pivot program to open it. This will open two windows.
- 9. Close the window that says "Computer class is fun". You will be looking at the Pivot program.
- 10. You are going to create a story animation that is at least 85 slides.
- 11. Play around with the program. There are a few options located on the left side bar and under the "File" and "Option" menus at the top.
- 12. You can change the color of your character(s); add more characters (File→Load Figure Type); create characters (File→Create Figure Type); load picture background—you need to save an image from the web (File→Load Background); adjust the size of your "paper" (Option menu).
- 13. The figures can be moved around the screen by clicking and dragging on the yellow circle in their center.
- 14. Add new frames by clicking "next frame".
- 15. Make sure you SAVE as you work. File → Save Animation, navigate using the side options to your folder or a create a new folder on your desktop.
- 16. Once you have your animation finished (you have 2 class periods and needs to be <u>at least</u> 85 slides); File → Save Animation. Change the bottom option where it says "Pivot File" to "Animated GIF" and save it again somewhere you will remember.
 - a. Log into your email.
