- a. Title=STATE NAME (press enter) STATE MOTTO
- b. Your Name, Class Period, go in the second box
- c. Make the font size at least 40, but make sure it stays on the page

### 2. 2 Content Slide

- a. Title=STATE FACTS
- b. Left Text Box
  - i. Year it became a state
  - ii. Which state number is it
  - iii. The Capital City
  - iv. How many STATE Senators
  - v. How many STATE Representatives
- c. Right Text Box
  - i. Add a clipart that represents the state

#### 3. 2 Content Slide

- a. TITLE=GEOGRAPHY
- b. On the website, click on Geography and find some facts
- c. Left Text Box
  - i. Add 5 facts about your state
- d. Right Text Box
  - i. Add a clipart that represents the state

#### 4. Title Slide

- a. Title=POPULATION
- b. On the website, click on Population. Press Alt+Print Scrn buttons on your keyboard.
- c. Back in Powerpoint, Right-Click on the slide—Paste. Change the size to make it fit the slide better
- d. Adjust the picture so you can see the title at the top of the slide. You can Crop the image so just the graph is showing (double click on image, look for "Crop" in the ribbon)
- 5. Title and Content Slide
  - a. Title=MAP
  - b. Insert a clip-art Map of your state
- 6. Title Slide
  - a. Title=STATE SYMBOLS
  - b. Insert 4 different clip-arts about your state. They need to be state symbols. You can find this information on the website.
    - i. Examples:
      - 1. Bird, Fish, Flower, Tree, Song, Animal, Color, Bug, etc.
