- 1) Slide 1: Title Slide

 - b) Name, Period
- 2) Slide 2: 2 Content Slide
 - a) Information about Me
 - b) How old are you exactly?

 - c) What does your name mean? Use your first name (if you can find information about your last name, include it)
 - d) Include 1 piece of relevant clip art
- 3) Slide 3: Title and Content slide
 - a) What happened in History the day you were born
 - i) List 5 historical facts about the day you were born; include the year that it happened.
(1) Use only facts **before** your birth.
- 4) Slide 4: Title and Content Slide
 - a) What happened in History the month you were born in
 - i) List 5 historical facts that happened during the month you were born in; include the year it happened.
(1) Use only facts **before** your birth.
- 5) Slide 5: Title and Content Slide
 - a) What happened in History the year you were born
 - i) List 5 facts that happened the year you were born.
 - ii) Include 1 piece of relevant clip art
- 6) Slide 6: Title and Content Slide
 - a) Fun Facts about the year you were born
 - i) Cost of a postage stamp
 - ii) Cost of a loaf of bread
 - iii) Average cost of a house
 - iv) Average cost of a car
 - b) Include 2 pieces of relevant clip art
- 7) Slide 7: Title and Contact Slide
 - a) Fun Facts Continued
 - i) Cost of a gallon of gas
 - ii) Who was President of the United States?
 - iii) Who was Vice-President of the United States?
 - iv) Who won the Academy Award for Best Picture that year?
 - b) Include 2 pieces of relevant clip art
- 8) Slide 8: Title and Content Slide
 - a) Fun Facts Continued
 - i) Top 5 songs and their artists
 - ii) Who won the Super Bowl that year?
 - b) Include 2 pieces of relevant clip art
- 9) Slide 9: Title and Content Slide
 - a) Wrap up
 - i) You will write a **2-paragraph** essay describing the meaning of your name, how long you've been alive, and what you thought was the most interesting thing from history having to do with the day, month, and year you were born. Use correct grammar, punctuation, and sentence structure.
